May Premium Adjustments Due to COVID-19

We are now able to confirm the following credits, which represent portions of the premium you were billed for May, will be applied to your June billing:

- Dental: 50% premium adjustment
- Extended Health: 10% premium adjustment

Once again, there is nothing for you to do. **These credits will be applied automatically.** While certain healthcare providers were given permission to reopen at the start of May, we will continue to support firms and their employees in this way until such time as employees are able to make use of these services and claims experience begins to return to normal.

Determine plan for seasonal inventory - Non-essential retail

Contract & references:

- Review contract, understand areas related to supply chain, delivery of goods / service offer
- Understand price point volume

Risk Assessment of suppliers: Two factors to assess risk - degree of impact of COVID-19 to the supplier and criticality of supplier to retailer's business

Retail Operations: Three key priorities for retailers

- 1. Supply chain management**
 - Stabilize supply & adapt to new demand
- 2. Inventory management**
 - Keep relevant items in stock while avoiding wastage
- 3. Store operations**
 - Flexibly manage operating processes, including labour & operating hours, while demand remains uncertain
